**Minutes of the Landscape Committee Meeting
Held on November 10, 2005**

A meeting of the Kensington Park Master Association Landscape Committee was held at 2:00 pm on Thursday, November 10, 2005, at the Kensington Golf & Country Club, 2700 Pine Ridge Road, Naples, Florida.

A quorum being present the meeting was called to order at 2:13 pm.

- Craig with Landscape Florida discussed the removing of the thryallis on south side and removal of the hibiscus along the Pine Ridge wall. Philodendron needs to be salvaged or removed. The annuals will be planted after a couple of weeks and after all of the cleanup has been done.
- Ron Hinding took this time to put a special Thank You to both Craig Hutchinson & Corey McDonough for their help and assistance throughout the clean up process of hurricane Wilma.
- Ron & Dale Slabaugh, Landscape Architect walked across Pine Ridge Rd. to assess the damage done to the trees down after Wilma and it was determined that there will be more work to be done. By the next committee meeting in December it will be determined which direction the entrance and other areas will need work on.
- Landscape Florida is to start working on the Eatonwood Lane entrance, as most of that area didn't sustain any damage. The ficus on both corners of Eatonwood & Kensington High St. will be removed and replaced with Chinese Fan Palms.
