**Minutes of the Landscape Committee Meeting
Held on December 8, 2005**

A meeting of the Kensington Park Master Association Landscape Committee was held at 2:00 pm on Thursday, December 8, 2005, at the Kensington Golf & Country Club, 2700 Pine Ridge Road, Naples, Florida.

Present at the meeting were: Marie Harris; Ron Hinding; Bill McKinney; Corey McDonough; Landscape Florida – Craig Hutchinson. Absent were Chuck Gass; Wayne Nelson and Al Staley.

A quorum being present the meeting was called to order at 2:00 pm.

- Review of cleanup activities:
 - Trees removed and stumps ground – around 200 plus trees
 - Trees straightened – Landscape Florida to finish approximately 20-25 more
 - Cuban Laurels behind Canterbury – job is half finished
 - Bismarck's (6) at the front gate to be cut back
 - Fence line inside and out to be cleaned and trimmed
- Craig with Landscape Florida updates:
 - Eatonwood Lane enhancements to be completed by Christmas
 - Sheffield enhancements that have already been approved to be completed first quarter of 2006
 - Will complete the mulching as new plants are introduced
 - Cut back awabuki bordering La Costa as soon as possible
 - Knightsbridge monument area – Tree Care will straighten up the monument, shore it up and Craig & Corey will fill in the wash out bank area
 - Will rake out stump grinding areas by year end
- Corey to complete the annuals planting by 12/16
- Dale made presentation of proposed “conceptual” plans for the Pine Ridge entrance, along the Pine Ridge wall and the two corners highlighting the major items to be changed. A motion was made to approve the “conceptual” plans was seconded and passed with a unanimous vote. Dale will supply a landscape plan for Knightsbridge by next meeting.

With no further business to discuss a Motion to adjourn was made at 4:00 pm.
